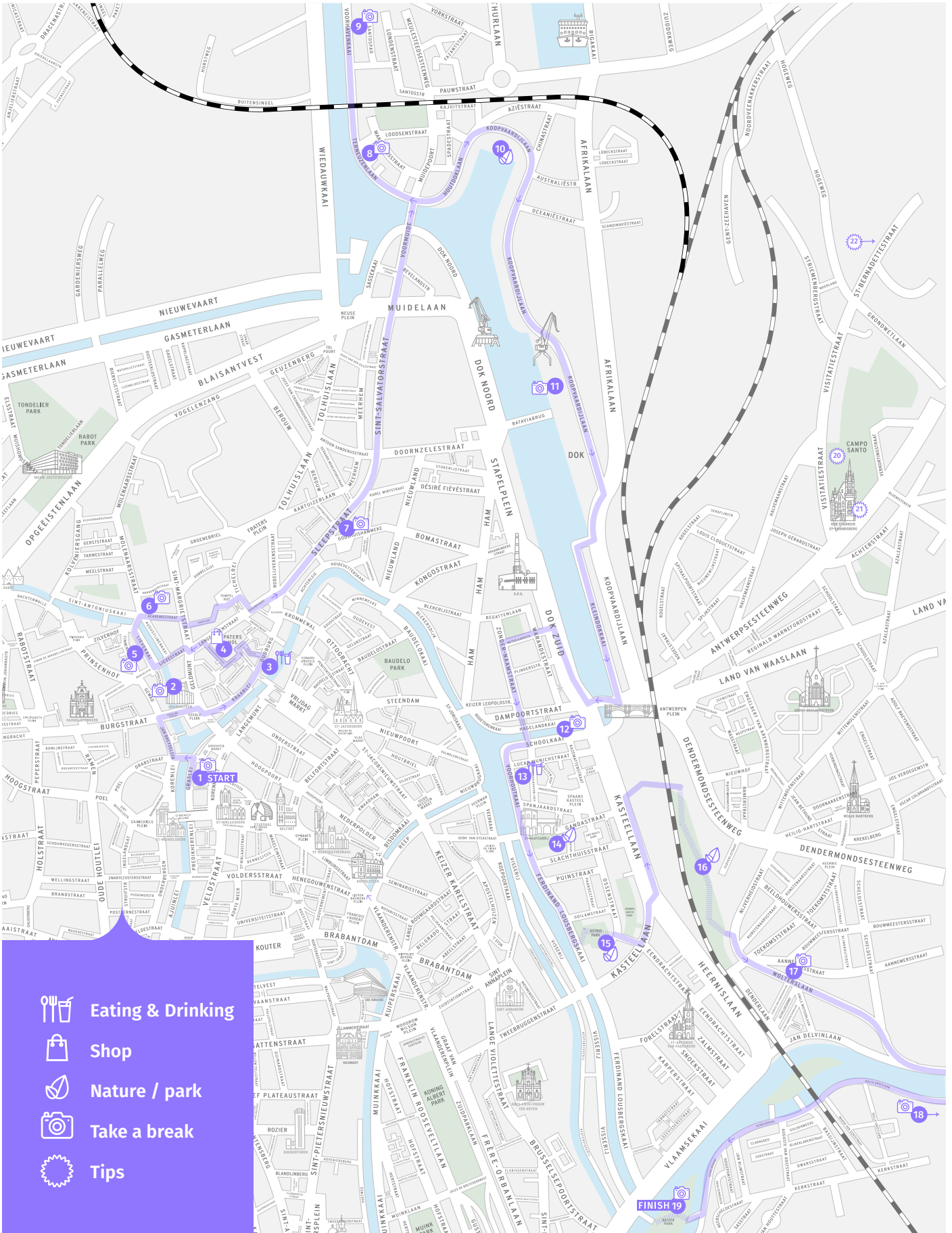

- 1 **Graslei:** the heart of Ghent. Enjoy the atmosphere and lighting.
- 2 **Castle of the Counts:** Ghent's genuine medieval castle.
- 3 **Jigger's:** probably Ghent's best-known cocktail bar.
- 4 **Patershol:** medieval and very picturesque neighbourhood.
- 5 **Lievekaai:** picturesque quay in the middle of Prinsenhof.
- 6 **Academiestraat:** the site of the former Academy of Fine Arts, Bieke's old school.
- 7 **Sleepstraat:** multicultural working-class street full of great restaurants and fun shops.
- 8 **Terneuzenlaan:** Ghent's harbour in full effect.
- 9 **Voorhavenkaai:** redeveloped and popular area in Ghent.
- 10 **Kapitein Zeppos park:** recently created park with beach.
- 11 **Schipperskaai:** also known as the Tinder Highway.
- 12 **Hagelandkaai:** Portus Ganda with beautiful views.
- 13 **A Taste Affair:** wineshop with a wide range of natural wines.
- 14 **Coyendanspark:** park next to St Bavo's Abbey.
- 15 **Koningin Astridpark:** charming little park.
- 16 **Bijgaardepark:** a leafy park on the site of a former textile factory.
- 17 **Wolterslaan:** wonderful tree-lined avenue.
- 18 **Arbedpark:** a former industrial site on the banks of the Scheldt.
- 19 **Keizerpark:** skateboarding park full of tricks & grinds!

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**Campo Santo cemetery in Sint-Amandsberg:** impressive cemetery.

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**Saint Amandus chapel:** regularly serves as a venue for exhibitions.
